Re: **Employee COVID-19 Vaccination Percentages**

Please see the attached information showing the latest number of employees who have been vaccinated as of October 10, 2021.

The overall average has increased to now 79 percent of the employee base with 12 County departments at 95 percent vaccinated or above. The attached data shows employee vaccination by department/agency from lowest to highest percent vaccinated.

The Sheriff's Department continues to have the lowest overall vaccination rate of employees at 57 percent. This is quite surprising since COVID-19 is now the leading cause of death for police officers in the United States. According to *The Wall Street Journal* some 420 have died from the disease since January 2020, compared with 92 who have died from gunfire, the second-leading cause of death.
