Re: **Retirement of Pima County Finance Director Michelle Campagne**

Ms. Michelle Campagne, Director of the Pima County Department of Finance & Risk Management, has announced her intention to retire in July 2022. The process to hire the new Finance & Risk Management Director will begin immediately.

For 21 years, Ms. Campagne has served Pima County and has led our award-winning Finance & Risk Management Department since 2018. Ms. Campagne joined Pima County as the Controller of the County's Kino Community Hospital. From there, Ms. Campagne managed the financial division within the Regional Wastewater Reclamation Department before transferring into the Finance and Risk Management Department in 2004 as the Financial Management and Audit Division Manager. Prior to assuming the role of Director in 2018, Ms. Campagne was the Deputy Director for eight years and, among her other duties, was the primary person responsible for managing Pima County's new debt issues and Capital Improvement Project funding. Ms. Campagne worked for nine years in the Office of the Auditor General for the State of Arizona before joining Pima County.

I am pleased to report that while she will be leaving her role as Department Director, Ms. Campagne will be joining the staff of the County Administrator's Office where she will provide policy support, research and advice related to the County's complex financial operations.

Over the next few months, I will finalize the search process, with a goal of hiring the new Director by the start of the new Fiscal Year.
