Re: **Our June 1, 2015 Meeting Regarding Soccer**

Dear Mr. Schmidt:

It was a pleasure to meet with you, Ebie Aldaghi and Leslie Johnson.

The following is a summary of our meeting:

1. The discounted youth field costs of Kino Sports Complex and Reach 11 are fairly comparable, with perhaps lighting costing more.
2. We are hopeful both the President's Cup and State Cup can be held at the Kino Sports Complex next year. It would appear that scheduling would permit such. While there may be some conflict with the Tucson Soccer Academy soccer tournament, please continue to work with us to see if we can make arrangements to allow fields that may have baseball conflicts to be used for this purpose.
3. Regarding spectators bringing their own water, this will not be a problem. The County has a policy that will allow all spectators to bring in water so long as it is in a sealed bottle so that alcohol cannot be brought into our public facility by spectators.
4. There will be two entrances to the event, one for the public and one for the players, coaches and referees. The players, coaches and referees may bring

any drink, food or snacks they deem necessary for themselves. These products shall not make their way to spectators.


5. Tent stakes and poles are not permitted on the grass surfaces. We would prefer that spectators with chairs remain in the hard clay areas so as not to damage the playing surface.
6. Once the additional fields are completed at Rillito Park, soccer will be prioritized over all other uses.

I believe this is an appropriate summary of the conclusions we reached at our meeting. We will also examine your proposed Kino field allocation plan contained in your handout.

We are and continue to be very interested in expanding the awareness of the youth soccer community and others to the amenities available at Kino. We hope, in the near term, to significantly expand the soccer complex component of the facility with approval by the voters of the November 2015 bond program.

Thank you for meeting with me and Messrs. Hank Atha and Chris Bartos. I appreciate your patience and allowing us to work with Arizona Youth Soccer organizations.
