Pima County is currently considering whether or not to take the proposed bond initiative to a public vote. The Y supports the bond election in November 2015 as it will provide much needed resources for the community and help spur the economy, initially through construction and then, over the long term, with permanent positions at organizations – like the Ys – providing services.

The Y would be one of many beneficiaries of the bond including the following two YMCA projects:

1. A 40,000 square foot Regional YMCA at the University of Arizona Tech Park that would include park space and serve the Tech Park, Vail and Rita Ranch residents. This project is a joint Library/YMCA collaboration.
2. YMCA Community Center that the Town of Sahuarita has identified as their #1 priority.
