I would love to see more bicycle related projects as county bond issues. I'm not convinced that \$5 million on a velodrome is a good use of taxpayer dollars or the best way to promote healthy lifestyles and encourage riding bikes as a hobby or means of transportation. Track seems to be a particularly specialized genre of cycling that I think has limited appeal to people who aren't already cyclists. If the goal is really to get more kids on bikes in a safe environment, \$5 million could go much much further in trail maintenance, on street bike infrastructure in key areas, and outreach and support of local would be cyclists through targeted programs and support networks.

The UofA impact report leans heavily on the Rock Hill case study, going so far as to say "we expect at least \$5 million return on investment over 20 years because their impact study predicted that much and we are similar." As far as I can tell, there are no post construction studies or actual revenue figures from any of these velodrome projects. Am I mistaken? Do we have anything more concrete showing that the county will get a return on investment? Do you guys have copies of the Rock Hill report? (I couldn't find it online.) Because right now, both the financial and the ethereal arguments (do it for the children and to be healthy!) seem tenuous.

And an education center and practice safety site? The county residents already have >\$5million of those: parking lots with some cones.

I share these opinions in the interest of helping you guys flesh out your arguments. Right now, it's weak. I'm an avid cyclist and I wouldn't spend a dollar of my taxes on this. Convince me why I should. If the arguments are as thin as they seem, I'd rather you guys just say local teams and coaches and event promoters and planners want a track so we can host and complete in more cycling events. That's fine, too. I'll come race at the track once or twice, but I don't think it should be subsidized based on current projections.

the course of the previous years, all major league baseball teams' spring training camps had departed Tucson. A few years later, we also lost our minor league team. The loss of the minor league play and spring training camps was truly a blow to Tucson's appeal to visitors and new residents. Yet five years later, we still pour scarce tax dollars and precious water resources into no fewer than 8 manicured baseball fields that sit largely unused at the Kino Sports Complex. While we all want to see the tradition of spring baseball in Tucson continue, it is wasteful to maintain such a large investment in a vastly underutilized recreational resource.

During my time living and working in Tucson, I have been fortunate to regain fitness in middle age through first recreational cycling and then competitive cycling. I have enjoyed seeing improvements in Tucson's cycling infrastructure, with the region's excellent bike commuting infrastructure, continued development of The Loop, ongoing popularity of El Tour de Tucson and other recreational rides, as well as vibrant road, mountain, and BMX bicycle racing communities that attract bicycle tourists from the region, the nation, and the world. But one component of this infrastructure remains elusive--the development of a track cycling program on par with the rest of Tucson's cycling attractions.

As it stands now, Arizona cyclists interested in pursuing track cycling must travel to California, Colorado, or Texas to pursue their sport. When I travel to neighboring states for a weekend competition--which I do several times per year--I spend \$1000 per trip on fuel, food, lodging, race fees, and incidentals. I have invested \$15,000 in my cycling equipment, between multiple bicycles, clothing, safety gear, tools, food, electronics, and other gear. Investment on this scale is typical of cyclists, and we should make every effort to attract visitors to our region who have this degree of discretionary spending potential. Construction of a velodrome in Tucson is a great way to bring this type of visitor to the Tucson region from elsewhere in the region. 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
