- participate in monthly meetings to analyze data, identify needs, and explore opportunities for training and other enhancements with the Pima County Business Services Team
- explore efforts to assist employees with long-term financial stability like workplace financial classes and loan programs

ERNs save time for HR and supervisory staff and help prevent otherwise valued employees from quitting or being terminated due to personal problems.
