It would assist staff in this review if the following unnamed documents cited in the ADEIS could also be provided as soon as possible:

- Document name unknown. Provide report and report citation for the claim that an underground mine is infeasible. Appendix references Rosemont Copper, Doc. X (Chapter 2, Page 55, Lines 4 and 5). Legal right to access mineral rights referenced (Document X) again in Chapter 2, Page 57, Lines 7 through 15.
- Document name unknown. Provide the pit configuration report and the Forest Service's review of this report, referenced in Chapter 2, Page 55, Line 14.
