Dear Mr. Huckelberry:

Thank you for your letter of July 13, 2011. In your letter, you stated that your office is in the process of gathering the responsive documents to Rosemont Copper Company's ("Rosemont") July 8, 2011 public records request, but did not provide any date when Rosemont could expect to receive the documents. Please let us know whether you believe your office will make the responsive documents available on or before July 22, 2011, which is two weeks from the date of the public records request. Additionally, it is unclear whether your office will also respond to the public records request that was sent to all five of the Pima County Board of Supervisors, the Pima County Office of Conservation Science & Environmental Policy, and Pima County Information Technology Department, or whether you were simply referring to the records request sent to the Pima County Administrator's Office.

Further, while Rosemont agrees to pay the reasonable costs your office incurs in copying any responsive documents, it is not responsible for the cost of searching for the records. *See Op.*
