MEMORANDUM OF DECISION

The Pima County Board of Adjustment, District 4, at a regular hearing held on **Tuesday, June 11, 2019**, heard the following appeals and decided as noted:

HEARING:

P19VA00010 ZIMMERMAN FAMILY TR – E. TURKEY RUN ROAD.

Robert Zimmerman represented by Peter Norton on property located at **11217 East Turkey Run Road**, (Mount Lemmon) in the RVC zone, requests a **Temporary Use Permit** to allow a retail shop while the owner seeks development plan submittal and approval. Section 18.93.040A of the Pima County Zoning Code states the board of adjustment may issue a temporary use permit for a building or premises in any zone for a use not therein permitted by this code. The permit shall be for not more than a nine month period and may not be renewed.

*The Board of Adjustment **APPROVED** requested **Temporary Use Permit**.*

An application for necessary permits for use of the property and construction shall be made within nine months of the granting of a variance and within thirty days of the issuance of a temporary use permit. Failure to apply for necessary permits within the time limit shall render the variance or temporary use permit null and void.
