



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Lake Mead & Powell Status





Lake Powell

Lake Mead



Snow accumulation through Mar 13 for the Colorado River Basin above Lake Powell, is >125% of the 30-year median

The April-July inflow to Lake Powell is projected to be 84% of the 30-year average
