Secretary Hobbs:

The undersigned are members of the Pima County Election Integrity Commission.

You were recently invited by our Chairman, Mr. Brian Bickel, to attend a meeting of the Pima County Election Integrity Commission to discuss "issues and concerns that we have with changes made by the Previous Secretary of State." Enclosed is a copy of his invitation dated April 9, 2019.

Also enclosed is a copy of the draft of the letter to you that we, the Commissioners, in regular session discussed and unanimously approved to be sent. Unfortunately, that was not the letter that you received. The Chair did not discuss the substantive changes to the original draft with the full Commission before it was sent out. We would not have agreed to the changes as we believe they are divisive in nature and contrary to the bipartisan working atmosphere we have worked to achieve.

Further, this action may be a violation of the Open Meeting Statutes.

Had the Chairman consulted the full Commission he would have found we have other concerns, including problems with "ballot harvesting" and verification of voters' signatures on early ballots.




