

15% Maintenance and Operations Budget Override

PROPOSITION NO. 400

Shall the Governing Board of Marana Unified School District No. 6 of Pima County, Arizona, adopt a General Maintenance and Operation Budget which exceeds the revenue control limit specified by statute by fifteen percent for fiscal year 2010-2011 and for six subsequent years as described below? The 2010-2011 budget override authority represents an extension and increase of the existing budget override authority which is scheduled to phase down by one-third in each of fiscal years 2012-2013 and 2013-2014 if the voters do not approve the override. If the voters approve the fifteen percent override, the fifteen percent override will replace the District's current ten percent override authority. If the voters do not approve the fifteen percent override, the District's current ten percent override authority remains in place, subject to the previously mentioned phase-down schedule.

The amount of the proposed increase of the proposed budget over the alternate budget for fiscal year 2010-2011 is estimated to be \$3,245,495. In fiscal years 2010-2011 through 2014-2015 the amount of the proposed increase will be fifteen percent (15%) of the District's revenue control limit in each of such years, as provided in Section 15-481(P) of the Arizona Revised Statutes. In fiscal years 2015-2016 and 2016-2017 the amount of the proposed increase will be ten percent (10%) and five percent (5%), respectively, of the District's revenue control limit in each of such years, as provided in Section 15-481(P) of the Arizona Revised Statutes.

Any budget increase authorized by this election shall be entirely funded by a levy of taxes upon the taxable property within this school district for the year for which adopted and for six subsequent years, shall not be realized from monies furnished by the state and shall not be subject to the limitation on taxes specified in Article IX, Section 18, Constitution of Arizona. Based on an estimate of assessed valuation used for secondary property tax purposes, to fund the proposed increase in the school district's budget would require an estimated tax rate of \$1.0774 per one hundred dollars of assessed valuation used for secondary property tax purposes and is in addition to the school district's tax rate which will be levied to fund the school district's revenue control limit allowed by law.

Shall the Governing Board of Flowing Wells Unified School District No. 8 of Pima County, Arizona, adopt a General Maintenance and Operation Budget which exceeds the revenue control limit specified by statute by fifteen percent (15%) for fiscal year 2010-2011 and for six subsequent years as described below? The 2010-2011 budget override authority represents an extension and increase of the existing ten percent budget override authority which is scheduled to phase down by one-third for fiscal year 2012-2013 if the voters do not approve the override.

The amount of the proposed increase of the proposed budget over the alternate budget for fiscal year 2010-2011 is estimated to be \$1,274,700. In fiscal years 2010-2011 through 2014-2015 the amount of the proposed increase will be fifteen percent (15%) of the District's revenue control limit in each of such years, as provided in Section 15-481(P) of the Arizona Revised Statutes. In fiscal years 2015-2016 and 2016-2017 the amount of the proposed increase will be ten percent (10%) and five percent (5%), respectively, of the District's revenue control limit in each of such years, as provided in Section 15-481(P) of the Arizona Revised Statutes.

Any budget increase authorized by this election shall be entirely funded by a levy of taxes upon the taxable property within this school district for the year for which adopted and for six subsequent years, shall not be realized from monies furnished by the state and shall not be subject to the limitation on taxes specified in Article IX, Section 18, Constitution of Arizona. Based on an estimate of assessed valuation used for secondary property tax purposes, to fund the proposed increase in the school district's budget would require an estimated tax rate of \$1.5753 per one hundred dollars of assessed valuation used for secondary property tax purposes and is in addition to the school district's tax rate which will be levied to fund the school district's revenue control limit allowed by law.

PROPOSITION NO. 402

Shall the Governing Board of Sahuarita Unified School District No. 30 of Pima County, Arizona, adopt a General Maintenance and Operation Budget which exceeds the revenue control limit specified by statute by fourteen percent (14%) for fiscal year 2010-2011 and for six subsequent years as described below? The 2010-2011 budget override authority represents an extension and increase of the existing ten percent budget override authority which is scheduled to phase down by one-third for fiscal year 2010-2011 if the voters do not approve the override and replaces the existing Kindergarten to Grade Three (K-3) five percent budget override.

The amount of the proposed increase of the proposed budget over the alternate budget for fiscal year 2010-2011 is estimated to be \$889,514. In fiscal years 2010-2011 through 2014-2015 the amount of the proposed increase will be fourteen percent (14%) of the District's revenue control limit in each of such years, as provided in Section 15-481(P) of the Arizona Revised Statutes. In fiscal years 2015-2016 and 2016-2017 the amount of the proposed increase will be nine and one-third percent (9 1/3 %) and four and two-thirds percent (4 2/3 %), respectively, of the District's revenue control limit in each of such years, as provided in Section 15-481(P) of the Arizona Revised Statutes.

Any budget increase authorized by this election shall be entirely funded by a levy of taxes upon the taxable property within this school district for the year for which adopted and for six subsequent years, shall not be realized from monies furnished by the state and shall not be subject to the limitation on taxes specified in Article IX, Section 18, Constitution of Arizona. Based on an estimate of assessed valuation used for secondary property tax purposes, to fund the proposed increase in the school district's budget would require an estimated tax rate of \$1.0353 per one hundred dollars of assessed valuation used for secondary property tax purposes and is in addition to the school district's tax rate which will be levied to fund the school district's revenue control limit allowed by law.
