Courier Service (Valid Class D Arizona Driver's License Required)	October 13-November 13, 2020

QUALIFICATIONS:

- Be a registered voter with current registration in Pima County
- Reliable transportation to various sites throughout Pima County
- Be able to work on-call, as needed, which could include some weekends, some overtime for limited periods of time.
- Paid training. Must attend training to perform tasks.

PAY:

\$14.40-\$15.40/hour, depending on task. Paid overtime compensation.
Positions are temporary, part-time, and do not include benefits.
