

PDEQ has modified the permit in direct response to public comments as discussed in the Response to Comments Document. At this time, PDEQ has determined the proposed air quality permit complies with all applicable federal, state, and local air quality regulations and is issuing air quality permit #1571 to Brush Ceramics.
