Dear Mr. Spencer:

The Pima County Department of Environmental Quality (PDEQ), is hereby issuing and providing you with notice of its final permit decision on PSD Permit No. 1052 for the Irvington Generating Station Project. PDEQ initially issued PSD Permit No. 1052 to Tucson Electric Power on August 8, 2018 under 40 CFR 124.15. By its own terms, and consistent with 40 CFR 124.15(b), the effective date of the permit was delayed as the result of the filing of a petition for review of PDEQ's permit decision with the EPA's Environmental Appeals Board ("EAB").

On December 3, 2018, the EAB denied the petition for review of this permit. Please see Tucson Electric Power, PSD Appeal No. 18-02 (EAB December 3, 2018), (Order Denying Review). Thus, in accordance with 40 CFR 124.19 (l) (2), this letter serves as the final permit decision by PDEQ for this permit. All conditions of PSD Permit No. 1052, as issued by PDEQ on August 8, 2018, are final and effective as of the date of this letter.

Public notice of this final agency action will be published in the Federal Register pursuant to 40 CFR 124.19 (l) (3).
