Pima County Department of Environmental Quality (PDEQ) staff has reviewed the permit renewal application for your facility located at 4201 W. Pima Mine Road, Sahuarita, Arizona and has determined that the application is incomplete pursuant to 17.12.160.B & 17.12.160.E.1.

The following information is required:

- 1) Data (based on approved test results) or manufacturer's data that supports all control efficiencies claimed in the renewal application.
- 2) A revised Compliance Assurance Monitoring (CAM) plan. The CAM plan submitted is a CAM plan for the control devices. A CAM plan is supposed to address the emission units not the emission control units. Emission control units are control technologies that may be used in order for the emission unit to comply with an emission limit.

Please ensure when replying to this letter that it is accompanied by a statement of truth, accuracy and completeness signed by the responsible official as required by PCC 17.12.160.E.1 and PCC 17.12.160.H.
