 - » Designated agents
 - » Contractor – for fee services; Regulatory reserves all authority
 - » Public agency
 - » University
 - » Private entity
 - Potential Roles of Third-Party Entities (TPE)
 - » Registry/document manager
 - » Independent verifier
 - » Reviewer/approver, acting as designated agent
 - AEE to develop an inventory of potential TPEs

- National Energy Efficiency Registry (NEER)
 - National web-based platform for tracking EE projects
 - Policy neutral
 - Built on best practices

- Funding – US DOE 2015 State Energy Grant to TN
- Six State partners (TN, MN, OR, MI, GA, PA)
- Supporting Partners (TCR)
- Steering/Advisory Committee – operating principals
- Multi-stakeholder Working Group
- Timeline: Mar 2017 – Oct 2017



EPA Clean Power Plan Developments

- **September 27 - Oral arguments heard on before *en banc* US Circuit Court for the District of Columbia (DC Circuit)**
 - Generation shifting – need clear congressional intent for “transformative changes”
 - Sec 112 prohibits regulation under Sec 111
 - Constitutional arguments – usurps State authority
 - Notice and comment rulemaking
 - Arbitrary and Capricious – “adequately demonstrated and achievable”
- **Clean Energy Incentive Program (CEIP)**
 - Proposal on “Design Details” issued June 30, 2016
 - Comments due November 1, 2016
