



Pima County Employee Guaranteed Ride Home REGISTRATION FORM

Pima County employees who use an alternate mode of transportation for work commutes at least twice per week are eligible to receive up to four free emergency rides every 12 months, courtesy of Pima County Department of Environmental Quality (PDEQ). If you are at work without a personal vehicle and an emergency arises, you may use a professional transportation company to take you to your home, to your vehicle, or to the emergency. You will have to pay the fee up-front and then submit a completed [GRH Trip Form](#) (with your supervisor's signature verifying the emergency need) and trip receipt to PDEQ for a cash reimbursement.
