GENERAL REQUIREMENTS

Storage of equipment and materials in the wash, drainageway, and floodplain is prohibited.

Unless disturbance is authorized, Regulated Riparian Habitat shall be protected during construction.

Natural grade shall be restored after completion of construction, unless shown otherwise on the construction plans referenced above.

Natural drainage shall not be altered, disturbed or obstructed, unless shown otherwise on the construction plans referenced above.

All other applicable permit requirements, including those required by Section 404 of the Clean Water Act, the Arizona Department of Environmental Quality and the Pima County Department of Environmental Quality, shall be met.
