\*A Certificate of Liability Insurance for the Permittee (contractor or property user) certifying minimum coverage of \$2,000,000 Each Occurrence and \$2,000,000 General Aggregate, naming Pima County and its Districts, 130 W. Congress Street, Tucson AZ 85701, as “Additional Insureds” to cover the permitted activities is required. Research institutes are exempt from the insurance requirement.

\*\*The number and schedule of inspections will be determined during the application review.

\*\*\*Right of Entry provided with permit is valid only for work on District owned property. Work impacting District Facilities on property owned by others may require separate property owner permissions.
