

The Pima County Regional Flood Control District (RFCD) would like to invite you to attend a meeting regarding the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers Tucson Drainage (Arroyo Chico) Project, Phase 2b. The project includes the excavation of three large detention basins between Cherry Fields and Fremont Avenue along the Arroyo Chico Wash. The constructed project will include native vegetation, multi-purpose trails and detention basins to accommodate floodwater storage.

The U.S. Army Corps of Engineers has hired Hunter Contracting to construct the project, and is preparing to begin construction in mid September 2010. RFCD has enlisted the assistance of biological specialists to undertake a biological survey and amphibian species salvage activities prior to construction. The biological specialists will present a summary of the Biological Survey and Species Salvage and Relocations Operation.
