PROPOSED CHANGES TO FLOODPLAIN AND FLOODWAY BOUNDARIES, AND FLOOD DEPTHS WITHIN THE PANTANO WASH FLOODPLAIN THROUGH THE FEDERAL EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT AGENCY AS PART OF THE NATIONAL FLOOD INSURANCE PROGRAM

The Pima County Flood Control District is proposing revisions to the floodplain and floodway boundaries and base flood elevations of the Pantano Wash based upon refined data and proposed bank protection improvements. The revisions are located within Sections 5 and 6 of Township 14 South, Range 15 East. The limits of the study are from Speedway Boulevard to Tanque Verde Road. The proposed revisions will change the Flood Insurance Rate Map (FIRM), panels 040192252K, 04019C2251K, and 04019C1663K for the City of Tucson in Pima County, Arizona. This action is required by the Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) as part of the National Flood Insurance Program (NFIP). Maps that delineate the proposed revised floodplain, floodway, and base flood elevations are available for review at the Pima County Regional Flood Control District, Floodplain Management Division, located at 97 E.
