

PUBLIC NOTICE

Proposed Changes to the Floodplain and Floodway Boundaries for the Santa Cruz River from just upstream of Grant Road to just downstream of Sweetwater Drive

The Pima County Regional Flood Control District has submitted proposed changes to the Santa Cruz River Floodplain and Floodway to the Federal Emergency Management Agency. The proposed floodplain/floodway revision for the Santa Cruz River starts approximately one-half mile upstream of Grand Road and extends north to the Trails End Wash confluence downstream of Sweetwater Drive. The proposed map revision, which reflects better topographic information, includes portions of Sections 20, 21, 27-29, and 33-35 of Township 13 South, Range 13 East and Sections 2 and 3 of Township 14 South, Range 13 East. If accepted the revised floodplain would modify Flood Insurance Rate Map 04019C1616K, 04019C1617K, 04019C1618K, 04019C1619K, 04019C1638K and 04019C2226K.
