The Hearing shall be held pursuant to Merit System Rule 14. A copy of the Appeal Hearing Guidelines has been provided to the Appellant for information and guidance of the Appellant and Respondent. Parties may represent themselves, or be represented by legal counsel, or by a third party representative, except as prohibited by law.

Persons with a disability may request reasonable accommodation, such as a sign language interpreter, by contacting the ADA Coordinator at Pima County Human Resources at 724-8028. Requests should be made as soon as possible in order to permit time in which to make arrangements for the requested accommodation.

Participation During COVID-19

Access will be limited and compliance to the following conditions are strictly enforced:

- Anyone exhibiting COVID-19 or influenza-like symptoms will not be admitted to the hearing.
- All persons participating in the hearing in-person are required to be vaccinated and wear a mask.

- Masks are required indoors when unable to maintain at least a six-foot distance between individuals.

Witnesses and documents should be presented by both sides at the time of the hearing. It is the responsibility of both the Appellant and Respondent to notify their witness(es) of the hearing and to make the necessary arrangements for their attendance. Copies of any and all correspondence submitted to the Commission must also be provided to the opposing party.

REQUIREMENT: Completed subpoena(s) for witness(es) to appear at this hearing and/or the production of any books, papers, or any other evidence relating to any hearing or investigation to be available for this hearing, must be received by Human Resources in accordance with the established subpoena procedure as set forth in the Appeal Hearing Guidelines.

IMPORTANT TO NOTE: A pre-hearing conference shall occur after the parties have exchanged discovery, but not less than two (2) business days before the hearing. Failure by either party to appear for this conference, in the absence of good cause, may result in the exclusion of evidence, the cancellation of the hearing by the hearing officer or commission, and/or granting of other relief by the Commission, including the dismissal or granting of the appeal.

At the conclusion of the Appeal Hearing, a decision will be made in Open Session.
