a. Grant Update by G. Moya-Flores

i. Emergency Response Funds. G. Moya-Flores no report. Asked J. West if the Pima Regional HazMat Response Team had received their equipment, reply was affirmative.

ii. Hazardous Materials Emergency Preparedness (HMEP). G. Moya-Flores reported funds obligated for the individuals that attended HotZone conference in October by Tucson Fire. There was a discussion initiated by M. Fosdick way attendance was small and only one department took advantage. Reasons were that it was mandatory for that departments personnel and for some departments it is difficult because initial funding comes from the department and then is reimbursed or they cannot release staff. That was followed that the LEPC should look for training opportunities that can be delivered locally. Projects under the grant are Hotzone Conference, NASTTPO Conference, Western Region SERC/TERC Conference, Continuing Challenge, IAFC Hazardous Materials Team Conference, Outreach Booth at SAEMS, AristTec/PEAC Software Package, HazMat IQ Above the Line/Below the Line training.

b. Training Update by S. Clark

i. Training opportunities include Pima County participation in the National Level Exercise 2020 in May. PCOEM will host Terrorist Liaison Officer (TLO) (January), ICS 300/400 (January and



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February) and All-Hazards Logistics Section Chief (February). PCOEM will host the 2020-2022 Multi-Year Training, Exercise, and Event Plan (MYTEP) Workshop (January).

### 6. Regional Hazmat Team Report by J. West

#### a. Reported Incidents

- i. No significant events to report. TFD has seen the normal trend increase this time of year with carbon monoxide and dioxide response.

#### b. Training.

- i. The Pima County Regional Hazmat completed their multiple days of multi-agency drills in December at Hills Brothers Chemical. Appreciation went out to M. Villegas and her team for not only providing the facility but also the role players (employees) to support the exercise. A summary with pictures was provided of the final report. Objectives included size-up, recon, rescue, HazMat ICS, resources, notifications, and mitigation of the release. S. Clark added that this exercise met the requirement for the annual exercise of the LEPC HazMat Plan. His summary was the operational capability of the departments participating under the Pima HazMat IGA, the ability of the team to work together, effective use of subject matter experts, and their methodical and safe approach in handling the released material.
- ii. Upcoming quarterly training includes Rad IQ, Decon, and Site Control.

#### d. Equipment – Equipment received includes smoke machine, RAD sources, NIOSH books, HazMat resupplies, calimetric tubes, and calibration gas.
