Draw from concealment, two-handed stances, shooting from cover, one-handed stances with either hand, speed reloading, and more are taught with an overall emphasis on fast, accurate shot placement. The course will culminate with a police-style qualification course. Estimated ammo count: 500 rounds. Prerequisite: basic understanding of firearms safety. This IS the range portion of the MAG 40 course and is taught by one of Mas Ayoob's senior instructors. Mas will conduct the legal portion in September of 2015.
