## Perfectly Imperfect Figure

Special Guest Instructor: Diana Farfan



This 2-day hands-on workshop focuses on hand-building the figure using anatomical references, while being playful with the body's proportions to accentuate meaning. Each day generally begins with a demonstration, and the rest of the day is devoted to hands-on work time with direction from the instructor. Demonstrations will include working with image references, modeling anatomy of hands and feet, casting a plaster mold of a small mask, and reproducing faces out of a mold to practice facial gestures.
