Must be currently employed by Pima County or the YMCA of Southern Arizona to take a Pima County Lifeguard review class

American Red Cross Lifeguard Review Classes are \$27.00. Fee is non-refundable. There is a pre-requisite swim of at least 300 yards continuously (using breaststroke and freestyle), treading water for 2 minutes without the use of arms, and a 10 pound brick retrieval so please be prepared. Class sizes are limited and are filled on a first come basis. In the event that the pool is closed due to weather or any other unforeseeable circumstance, the class may need to be extended to meet all objectives at the discretion of the head lifeguard instructor. A copy of your current American Red Cross Lifeguard Certificate will be collected on the first day of class. Call Jodi Layton at 520-724-5171 for more information and/or questions.
