The rifle and pistol range is located in Ajo Regional Park approximately 6-1/2 miles north of Ajo off of Ajo Well 1 Road

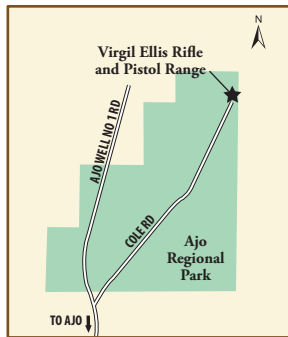

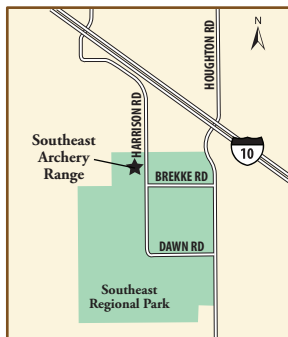
Facilities

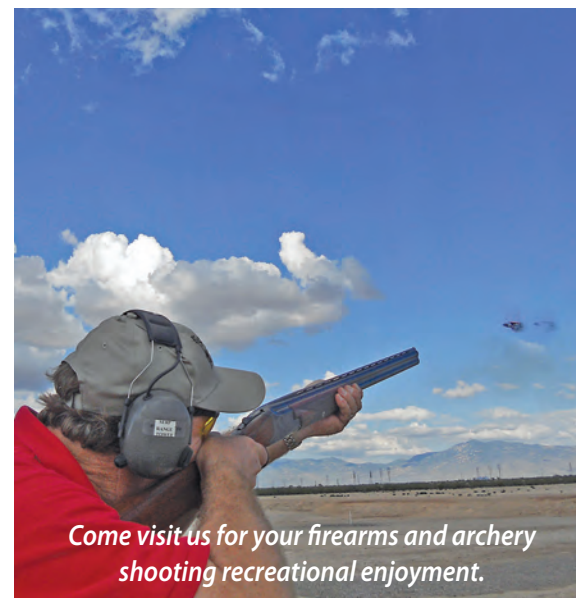
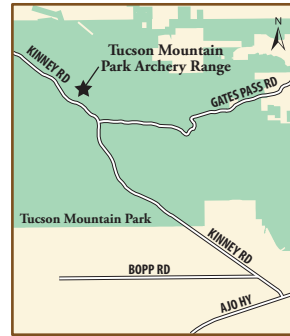

The Southeast Regional Park Shooting Range, Tucson Mountain Park Rifle and Pistol Range, Virgil Ellis Rifle and Pistol Range, the Clay Target Center, Southeast Archery Range and Tucson Mountain Park Archery Range are operated and managed by Pima County Natural Resources, Parks and Recreation. They are designed, built and operated to provide participants with safe and enjoyable shooting opportunities.

The Clay Target Center is situated across from the Southeast Regional Park Shooting Range and is located at 11295 S. Harrison Road. The Clay Target Center offers both Trap and Skeet for experienced and novice shooters, utilizing professional grade equipment in a beautiful setting.

Only shotguns 12 gauge and smaller are allowed and shot must be size 7.5 or smaller.

Rangemasters are NRA certified as both rangemasters and instructors. Rangemasters are available to answer questions and give some instruction.

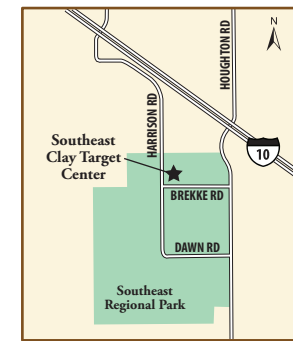
