

## Youth Day FAQ's

Who can register for the event?	Public schools, Charter schools and Home School students in 3 <sup>rd</sup> , 4 <sup>th</sup> , 5 <sup>th</sup> or 6 <sup>th</sup> grade (ages 8-12)
When & where is the event?	Thursday, January 30, 2020 9 a.m. – 2 p.m. at Old Tucson Studios 201 S. Kinney Rd, Tucson, AZ
How do we register?	The registration form is located on our website at <a href="http://www.pima.gov/nrpr">www.pima.gov/nrpr</a> . Complete the form and submit to <a href="mailto:lisa.uthe@pima.gov">lisa.uthe@pima.gov</a> by email, fax at 724-5078 or mail to Pima County NRPR attention Lisa Uthe at 3500 W. River Rd. How much does the event cost?	The event is free for public, private, charter and home school 3 <sup>rd</sup> , 4 <sup>th</sup> , 5 <sup>th</sup> and 6 <sup>th</sup> grade students and 1 chaperone* per every 10 students registered
Are teachers included in the chaperone count?	Yes, teachers are included in the chaperone* count ratio of 1:10
How many chaperones can we bring?	One chaperone for each 10 students is admitted free of charge
Can we bring extra chaperones to the event?	Yes, extra chaperones and family members can attend at the reduced price of \$11.50 adults/\$7.00 child paid at the entrance (taxes are included)
How do we get to the event?	Transportation to the event is the responsibility of the class attending
Who will receive the free hotdog lunch?	All students & chaperones associated with the registered school group will receive the free (all beef) hotdog lunch (including paid admissions). Please include the number of additional people attending outside the registered school group so that we can include them in the lunch count
Can we bring our lunches to the event?	No outside food is allowed into Old Tucson. Permission will be granted for students with special dietary needs only
Can we purchase lunch inside the event?	Yes, there will be areas inside the park to purchase food, snacks, ice cream, candy, souvenirs and additional activities (panning for gold etc.)
Can we bring in bottled water?	Yes, you can bring in bottled water. We will also provide bottled water at lunch.
When will we get our entrance information?	Your entrance packets will be mailed to your school approximately 2 weeks prior to the event to the attention of the contact provided
Can we bring special needs students?	Yes, we are more than happy to accommodate special needs students and their personal aids (personal aid not included in 1:10 ration). Please include this information on your registration form
What time is our lunch?	Your lunchtime will be included in the entrance packets sent to your school 2 weeks prior to the event. The times are also located on the map
Are backpacks allowed in the park?	Yes, they may be subject to search for security reasons
Will the event be cancelled due to weather?	No, the event will take place rain or shine. Please dress accordingly.

Will maps and Bingo sheets be available at the event? A limited number of maps/schedules will be available at Old Tucson on the day of the event. A very limited number of Bingo sheets will be available.
