TRAILHEAD GUIDELINES

- Be aware of seasonal weather conditions and take an ample supply of water with you
- Dogs must be leashed at all times; please clean up after your dog
- Stay on designated trails
- No commercial activity unless permitted by NRPR
- Motorized vehicles are prohibited on trails
- Trailheads are for trail access only; no loitering at trailheads or in other areas
- No alcohol
- It is illegal to remove or disturb any natural or cultural resources; no geocaching
- Wear a wide brimmed hat and apply sunscreen; wear sturdy, comfortable walking shoes and know your route
- Hike with a friend
- Inform someone where you are going and when you expect to return; know your limitations
- Carry a cell phone but be aware that reception may not be available in all areas
- Do not litter – pack it in, pack it out
- Be aware of cacti and venomous animals
- Do not feed wildlife
