November 19th, 2008


City of Tucson Parks and Recreation and Pima County Cultural Resources and Historic Preservation Office will be holding a public meeting from 6 p.m. to 8 p.m. on Wednesday, November 19th at the Carol W. West Senior Addition at Morris K. Udall Regional Park for the **Fort Lowell Park Master Plan**.

At this second public meeting, the consultant team will present three alternative concepts for the site along with criteria for their evaluation. There will be an opportunity for the public to critique and provide feedback on the three alternatives before a final concept is developed.

Planning for this 70 acre project includes a diverse collection of natural, cultural historical and recreational resources. A primary goal of the Master Plan is to integrate resources from the entire park, including those on the Adkins Parcel, located at the Southwest corner of Fort Lowell and Craycroft Roads. Existing recreational and sports fields and the natural area bordering the Pantano Wash are also included in the Master Plan.
