



## NOTICE OF INVITATION TO BID

Sealed bids for construction of the Camino De La Tierra Pedestrian Bridge shall be delivered by the date and time indicated below to the Pima County Procurement Department offices located in the County Administration Building, 130 West Congress Street, 3<sup>rd</sup> Floor, Tucson, Arizona 85701. Bids must be accompanied by a surety bond of five percent (5%) of the amount of the bid.

The projects are located within Section 8, Township 13 South, Range 13 East, Gila and Salt River Meridian, Pima County, Arizona.

The project consists of constructing a new pedestrian bridge crossing of Camino de la Tierra, its approach ramps and associated ancillary improvements to maintain access to the existing pathway and the existing trailhead and restroom facilities. The bridge structure will utilize salvaged precast pre-stressed concrete box beam girders from the Helmet Peak Bridge in the Town of Sahuarita, Arizona. The box beam girders are currently stored at the Pima County Storage Yard (CPC Southwest Materials, 6601 N Casa Grande Highway, Tucson, Arizona 85741). Davis-Bacon Prevailing Wages apply.

Estimated cost for the project is between \$775,000.00 and \$825,000.00. The project shall be complete and in place within 180 working days from Notice to Proceed. Liquidated damages for late delivery will be assessed per Pima County Standard Specification Section 108-9.

All bidders will be subject to Arizona Department of Transportation (ADOT) Registration and Disadvantaged Business Enterprise (DBE) requirements and reporting. Please review these requirements carefully. This project requires a minimum goal of 7.36% for participation by DBE's as a percentage of the total amount of the project's bid schedule.

The contractor must have the appropriate license issued by the State of Arizona Registrar of Contractors before award of the contract and maintain same through the duration of the project. Failure to obtain this license by the end of the sixtieth (60th) calendar day after bid opening may result in rejection of the bid without further recourse and award of the contract to the next low responsive, responsible bidder. Pima County reserves the right to reject any and all bids or to withhold the award for any reason.
