Q) Under the Evaluation Criteria Section 4a, it states to identify at least 3 comparable projects. If we identify more than 3 comparable projects, ie. 5 projects, do we need to have Consultant Performance Inquiries for each project?

A) You are only required to submit three Consultant Performance Inquiries.

Q) If we are utilizing the same agency for more than one project, can we use the same Consultant Performance Inquiry Form?

A) No, Consultant Performance Inquiries are for specific projects. The same agency would be required to complete separate forms for each project.

Q) If the Project Manager has retired from an agency, can we use someone else?

A) Contact the retired person and he/she can scan the form to me. You can use someone else who worked on the project and is familiar with the consultant's work.

Q) Under the Scope of Work 3.2.1.1, it refers to frequent return period events (10% and 4%), which do we use?

A) These are often referred to as 10-yr (10% annual flood) or 25-yr (4% annual flood). FEMA uses the '1% annual chance flood' to refer to the event often called 100-yr flood, so we are using % annual chance designation.

Q) Under the Evaluation Criteria Section 5c. what is meant by Regional Models?

A) Models that identify and evaluate drainage and flooding problems should be of this region, Pima County.

Q) Has the panel been select and who are the panel members?

A) The panel has been selected; however the names of the panel are confidential.

Q) What is the makeup of the panel?

A) The panel consists of two employees from Pima County Flood Control and one employee from the City of Tucson.

Q) On page 24 of the Scope of Work the requested model for TSMS discharges is at times elusive. How can we obtain this data?

A) The City assured us that the TSMS data can be obtained. However, we already have previous TSMS models for this area. Any consultant using the data would be responsible for their veracity under current conditions.

All other requirements and terms of the Solicitation remain unchanged.
