

**INVITATION FOR BID**

Sealed bids for Solicitation # 220020, OLD VAIL MIDDLE SCHOOL, VAIL (4OLVMS) and MARY ANN CLEVELAND WAY AT KUSH CANYON LANE, TUCSON (4TAMAC) Projects shall be delivered by the date and time indicated below to the Pima County Procurement Department offices located in the County Administration Building, 130 West Congress Street, 3<sup>rd</sup> Floor, Tucson, Arizona 85701. Bids must be accompanied by a surety bond of five percent (5%) of the amount of the bid.

The projects are located within Sections 8 and 9 of T16S, R16E, Gila and Salt River Meridian, Pima County, Arizona.

The project consists of furnishing all labor, materials, equipment and supervision necessary for improvements described in the project plans. The work consists of approximately 5,700 L.F. of paved pathway along the north side of Mary Ann Cleveland Way, from Red Iron Trail to Driscoll Mountain Drive and a High Intensity Activated Crosswalk (HAWK) signal installation at Kush Canyon Lane. Davis-Bacon Prevailing Wages apply.

Estimated cost for the project is between \$500,000.00 and \$600,000.00. The project shall be complete and in place within 75 working days from Notice to Proceed. Liquidated damages for late delivery will be assessed per Pima County Standard Specification Section 108-9.

All bidders will be subject to Arizona Department of Transportation (ADOT) Registration and Disadvantaged Business Enterprise (DBE) requirements and reporting. Please review these requirements carefully. For the Old Vail Middle School Mary Ann Cleveland Way Project, a minimum goal of 7.14% for participation by Disadvantaged Business Enterprises (DBE's) as a percentage of the total amount of the project's bid schedule. There is NO DBE requirement for the Mary Ann Cleveland Way at Kush Canyon Lane Project.

Bidders must be prequalified at the time of bid due date under the ARIZONA DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION, INTERMODAL TRANSPORTATION DIVISION, RULES FOR PREQUALIFICATION OF CONTRACTORS (R17-3-201 thru R17-3-204).

The contractor must have the appropriate license issued by the State of Arizona Registrar of Contractors before award of the contract and maintain same through the duration of the project. Failure to obtain this license by the end of the sixtieth (60th) calendar day after bid opening may result in rejection of the bid without further recourse and award of the contract to the next low responsive, responsible bidder. Pima County reserves the right to reject any and all bids or to withhold the award for any reason.
