**ADDENDUM NO. 01**

**SOLICITATION NO. 233172 - ANIMAL MICROCHIPS**

Be advised of the following changes, clarifications and/or additions to the above-referenced Solicitation as stated in the following Addendum.

**QUESTIONS/ANSWERS:**

Q. 1) In the offer agreement section 4.2 it states that "for all microchips, Contractor will provide initial registration and updates via Chameleon. Contractor will not charge County for initial microchip registration and updates."

Can you please clarify? When it says "all microchips" does this mean the ones purchased from the contractor only? Or does this apply to animals that come in to the shelter already with various brands of microchips that need to be registered?

A. 1) Our intention is to take advantage Chameleon's "Knowledge Rocket" program - which we would use to upload new and updated information daily. The most direct answer to the below questions is that the majority of registrations would be for new microchips purchased from the vendor and implanted in shelter animals for adoption; however there will be updates to our data base that are chips from other manufacturers (surrendered animals, strays, etc). There would also be incidents of people changing their information with licensing, should they move or whatever. So, the data uploaded will no doubt have information from various other vendor's microchips - but this will be the exception, rather than the rule.

Q. 2 It looks like, in order to submit a deviation request we have to send that in in advance. Do I just send you a letter on company letterhead via email?

A. 2) Request for deviations can be sent via email.

All other requirements and terms of the Solicitation remain unchanged. Failure to include acknowledgment of all addenda may be cause for rejection.
