TITLE VI NOTICE TO THE PUBLIC


The Pima County Department of Transportation hereby gives public notice that it is the Agency's policy to assure full compliance with Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964, the Civil Rights Restoration Act of 1987, and all related statutes and regulations in its programs and activities. Title VI requires that no person shall; on the grounds of race, color, sex, national origin, age, or disability; be excluded from the participation in, be denied the benefits of, or be otherwise subjected to discrimination under any Federal Aid Highway program or other activity for which Pima County receives Federal financial assistance.

Any person who believes his/her Title VI protection has been violated may file a complaint. Any such complaint must be in writing and filed with the Pima County Transportation Department's Title VI Coordinator within one hundred eighty (180) days following the date of the alleged discriminatory occurrence. Title VI Discrimination Complaint Forms may be obtained from the Pima County Transportation Department.


KEY ELEMENTS

- * Realign Bopp Rd to connect with Kinney Rd at the Sarasota Intersection.
- * Provide median divided intersection with left turn lanes.
- * Install a signal at the Kinney/Bopp/Sarasota Intersection.
- * Install Intersection Lighting.
- * East portion of existing Bopp Rd will be renamed Bopp Ranch Pl.
- * Roads will not be closed during construction. Traffic access through the project area will remain.
