Introduction

The Pima County Department of Transportation (PCDOT), in conjunction with the Federal Highway Administration (FHWA) and the Regional Transportation Authority (RTA), held a public open house to provide an update of the La Cañada Drive, River Road to Ina Road project and solicit public comment on the final design and proposed improvements.

The open house was held on Thursday, May 27, 2010, from 5:30 to 7:30 p.m., at the Tucson Chinese Cultural Center. Sixty-three people signed in. Representatives from Pima County and the project team were available to answer questions and address potential concerns about the project.

The sign-in sheets are included in Appendix A.

Public Notice

Notification for the public meeting included:

- Newspaper advertisement published in the *Arizona Daily Star* and the *Daily Territorial* on Thursday, May 7, 2010.
- A postcard invitation mailed on May 13, 2010 to approximately 2,300 area residents and businesses.
- Meeting information posted to the project website www.roadprojects.pima.gov/lacanada on May 14, 2010.
- E-mail invitation sent on May 20, 2010 to project distribution list.

Copies of the public notification materials are included in Appendix B.

Meeting Format, Materials and Presentation

At the open house, participants were asked to sign in and were provided an agenda, fact sheet, and comment form. RTA brochures were also available. The agenda outlined the topics of discussion for the meeting. Comment forms allowed the public to provide input on roadway design, drainage design, right-of-way and public art. General comments were also encouraged. Participants were requested to fill out and leave completed comment forms at the end of the meeting or send them in by June 10, 2010.

A presentation was given at 6:00 p.m. and began with a welcome address by Rick Ellis, Pima County Department of Transportation, Engineering Division Manager. Rick continued with the presentation by providing an update on the completed project efforts, the Community Advisory Committee, roadway design, drainage design, right-of-way acquisition and public art. After the presentation, participants were encouraged to visit project team members assigned to various information stations to ask questions. The stations included RTA Business Assistance, Public Involvement, Roadway Design, Drainage Design, Environmental, Public Art, Landscape Design, and Right-of-Way. Aerial maps were provided at staffed information stations.


Written Comments from the Public

- A HAWK or traffic light should be installed in front of La Cima Middle School.
- I'm in a flood plain now.
- I can't believe there isn't an artist in Tucson who can do the artwork, instead of someone from Colorado.
- Keep in mind tagging that needs to be painted over.
- I like that this project will be happening soon.
- I love the left-turn lane at Rudasill.
- Drainage design looks good.
- I feel sorry for the people who have lost their homes.
- I'm glad the simple and subtle concept has gotten across to the artist, like native landscaping.
- I don't think we need a four-lane highway running through a residential area.
- Noise levels and noise abatement is severely underestimated.
- The drainage design has been improved, but I think we're going to have a high volume of water flowing into the area.
- We're broke on every level. I don't know where the money is coming from.
- The south leg has been cheated. The bulk of the money went to the north.
- I love the design, but it looks expensive.
- You should be burying all power lines.
- I like rubberized asphalt.
- I wish sound walls would be added.

The Pima County Department of Transportation (PCDOT), the Regional Transportation Authority (RTA) and the Federal Highway Administration (FHWA) are finalizing plans and environmental documentation to improve La Cañada Drive from River Road to Ina Road. The plans call for La Cañada Drive to be widened to four lanes in order to accommodate increased traffic demands in the area for the year 2030; to improve vehicular, pedestrian, bicyclist and equestrian safety; and to provide a key north-south, all-weather surface for residents, commuters and emergency service providers in the northwest. Construction would begin in 2011.

Roadway Design

- Four-lane divided roadway with a 24-foot raised median and 6-foot shoulders.
- Concrete curbs and sidewalks on both sides with a multiuse path located on the west side.
- Rubberized asphalt paving to provide a durable, smooth riding surface and roadway noise mitigation.
- Noise walls per the 2008 Pima County Noise Abatement Procedure and FHWA criteria.
- Artwork that fits in contextually with the surrounding area.

Drainage

- Concrete box culverts at five major wash crossings (Roller Coaster, Las Lomitas, Citrus Wash, Casas Adobes and Chula Vista) plus smaller culverts at 18 other locations.
- Channel work at each wash crossing to improve inlet and outlet hydraulic performance.
- A closed stormwater drainage system consisting of catch basins, manholes and storm drains to collect and discharge stormwater from La Cañada Drive to the adjacent washes.

Right-of-Way

- Right-of-way acquisition is anticipated to complete the 150-foot right-of-way needed to construct the widened road and associated sidewalks and public-use trail.
- Drainage, slope and temporary construction easements are anticipated in conjunction with drainage improvements and roadway embankment construction along the road.

Utilities

- Overhead Western Area Power Administration (WAPA) and Tucson Electric power lines are located on the west and east sides of La Cañada Drive, respectively. Numerous poles will require relocation.
- Multiple utility franchises (Tucson Water, Metro Water, Pima County Regional Wastewater Reclamation Department (PCRWRD), Southwest Gas, Comcast, Tucson Electric Power Company, Qwest, etc.) are located along the corridor. Potential conflicts with their facilities are being assessed. Relocations will be required.

Public Involvement

- Ongoing communication and briefings with the Community Advisory Committee (CAC) members.
- Ongoing communication with the public.

Environmental

- An Environmental Assessment and Mitigation Report (EAMR) was prepared based on County requirements.
- A Categorical Exclusion (CE) was prepared to satisfy federal requirements.
