


# Valencia Road: Wilmot to Kolb PRE-CONSTRUCTION OPEN HOUSE



Improvements to Valencia Road, including the intersection with Kolb Road, are set to continue in order to increase capacity and enhance safety on the regional corridor. This Regional Transportation Authority construction project will be managed by the City of Tucson. The next phase of this project will continue the widening of Valencia Road, roughly one mile east and west of Kolb Road, 1/2 mile south of Valencia Road and 1/4 mile north of Valencia Road. The roadway will be widened to six lanes and include bike lanes, sidewalks, drainage structures, lighting, traffic signals and landscaping.

The approximate 12-month construction project, led by Tucson-based KE&G, is anticipated to begin in July 2018. Throughout the construction, one lane of traffic will be maintained in each direction and access to all properties and businesses will remain open.
