# Judging criteria:

The submitted artwork will be judged on its creativity, originality, visual impact and communication of the effect graffiti has on our community.

# Contest rules:

All participants must be 9 to 18 years old.

All artwork must be no larger than 8 ½ by 11 inches. Landscape (horizontal) is preferred. One entry per person.

Artwork can be realistic or abstract and must be suitable for all audiences and contain no obscenities or profanity.

Submitted artwork will not be returned.

All entries must be received by Friday, October 30, at 5 p.m.

Entries submitted after the deadline will not be accepted.



# Judging:

- A four-member committee of Pima County staff will review all entries based on the criteria above and select one finalist from each of the five age groups: **ages 9-10, 11-12, 13-14, 15-16, and 17-18.**
- In the event we don't receive entries from all age groups, the top five entries will be finalists.
- A three-member panel of community members will select the winner from the five finalists.
- The winner's artwork will be the design used for Pima County's Anti-Graffiti Campaign. The winner will receive a prize worth \$100 and the four runners-up will each receive a prize worth \$25.
- A press release will be distributed announcing the winner along with the design selected and the runners-up.
- All finalists' artwork will be featured on the Pima County TAAG website.
