Notice is hereby given that the Pima County Board of Supervisors will hold a public hearing on Tuesday, May 15, 2018, at 9:00 a.m. or thereafter, to consider for approval a Sales Tax Implementation Plan Ordinance. The Sales Tax Implementation Plan Ordinance does not levy a sales tax. It is a plan for how sales tax revenue will be used, and it will not become effective unless and until a resolution levying a general excise (sales) tax is approved by the Board of Supervisors. On or after June 19, 2018, the Board of Supervisors will consider the adoption of a resolution levying a general excise (sales) tax as authorized under A.R.S. ? 42-6103.
