GARDNER LANE AT ROMERO ROAD CLOSED FOR ONE WEEK

Pima County, Ariz. (Nov.6) – The Pima County Department of Transportation, the Regional Transportation Authority, and their contractor, Select Development & Construction, Inc., continue work on the Homer Davis Transportation Enhancement Project.

Gardner Lane Closed

Starting Monday, November 11, 2013, at 8:00 a.m. Gardner Lane will be closed just west of Romero Road (see attached map). The north and southbound lanes on Romero Road will not be impacted. Gardner Lane will reopen on Friday, November 15, 2013, at 5:00 p.m.

Crews will be performing manhole reconstruction work and roadway excavation to prepare for paving. Motorists may experience minor delays.

The Pima County Department of Transportation reminds motorists to obey traffic control signs and speed limits through the construction zone.
