1. Corona De Tucson and Surrounding Areas: In Progress
2. Town of Ajo Roadways: Awarded, Construction Start – Oct 5th
3. Catalina Area Roadways: Awarded, Construction Start – Sept 21st
4. Green Valley ADA Improvements: Bid package preparation ongoing
5. Remaining Local Roads: in development – Work will be out for bid by the end of November.

Pavement Repair Program Update

Arterials and Collector Roads (45.65 miles)

1. Mission Road – Final Striping completed Aug 17th
2. Snyder Road – Paving Complete, Final Striping Sept 10th
3. The Town of Ajo and Catalina Area Projects also include some collector roadways so they have been included in both tables.
4. Sandario Road: Hard Bid, Bid opening scheduled for 9/1/2020
5. Sahuarita Road – intended as JOC, in package development.
6. Other roadways - Hard Bid Contracts for combined Arterial and Collector Roads
7. Master Agreement for Surface Treatments and Crack Filling
 - In procurement process, treatments completion end of June 2021


