

Resolve to Recycle the Right Way



Approximately 40% of everything you throw out is recyclable. Follow these 3 simple steps to recycle more in 2018:

1. Recycle all empty plastic bottles, cans, paper and cardboard.
2. Keep food, liquid, diapers and other non-recyclables out of your Blue Barrel
3. Never bag recyclables – put items directly into your Blue Barrel.
(Hint: recycle plastic bags with a local retailer or grocer.)

- Meet combined household income requirements
