## 5 Ways to Donate or Recycle E-Waste

E-waste is electronic waste - TVs, computers, cellphones, smartphones, keyboards, mice and peripherals (printers, scanners, fax machines). **Nearly 100% of e-waste is recyclable.** Recycling e-waste keeps toxic metals out of our environment and puts them to beneficial use.

E-waste – in working order or not – can be recycled and donated:

- 1) Donate working cellphones or computer equipment to help others.** Discarded cellphones with battery power can connect to 911 emergency service.
- 2) Donate broken electronics to social service agencies** that repair equipment as part of job training.
- 3) Return your unwanted electronics** to your cellphone provider or retailers that sell electronics. Many have take-back programs to reduce waste.
- 4) Download the Tucson's free Recycle Coach app** ([tucsonaz.gov/es/my-waste](http://tucsonaz.gov/es/my-waste)). Click on the Do More Blue section for e-waste and other recycling options.

Due to the successful collection of **7,700** pounds of fats, oils, and grease at the **13th Annual Grease Collection and Recycling Event**, a permanent year-round collection site is now available for the community to deposit grease:

*The collected grease is recycled into biodiesel, a cleaner burning fuel.*
