- Aluminum and tin cans from beverages and foods
- Plastic bottles and jugs
- Paper and cardboard - flatten the cardboard and don't recycle wrapping paper with glitter or a metal finish
- Aluminum pans
- Glass bottles and jars



Do not recycle string lights, ribbon, recyclables with food residue, and Styrofoam.


Remember, Neighborhood Recycling Centers accept any recyclables you would put in your blue barrel. Visit tucsonaz.gov/recycle for more information.
