

2022 FILING PROCEDURES FOR CANDIDATES FOR NONPARTISAN OFFICES

Candidates for Nonpartisan offices do not have to file anything with our office prior to collecting signatures. Senate Bill 1492 made special district candidates exempt from filing the Statement of Interest that was required in 2020.

If a candidate receives contributions or makes expenditures, in any combination, of \$1300, the candidate must file a Statement of Organization with our office to register as a candidate committee. A candidate that files this form will be required to file periodic campaign finance reports using the Pima County Campaign Finance Software. Information about the software is available on our website. There is an instruction sheet in this packet showing you where to go on our website to download the software.

PETITION INFORMATION

PETITION FILING DATES ARE JUNE 13, 2022 THROUGH JULY 11, 2022 AT 5:00 PM.

Signature requirements for petitions will be based on the January 2, 2022 voter registration totals. The signature requirements will be available approximately 2 weeks after this date. You can find them on our website or call our office at 520-724-6830.

At the time of filing, candidates for nonpartisan offices need to turn in the following:

- 1. Petitions**
- 2. Nonpartisan Nomination Paper**

If you do not have both forms at the time of filing, your filing will not be accepted by our office.
