

Is the software compatible with Mac products?

Unfortunately, no. If you do not have access to a PC, you may use the fillable PDF version of the campaign finance forms (available on the campaign finance page of our website) and email your report to electionscf@pima.gov.

Can I use the software on multiple computers?

Not really. This is not a web-based software. After you download the program, any transactions and information that you enter are saved onto the hard drive of your computer. You will not be able to login from a different computer to access your data. In order to move your data from one computer to another, you would have to export it onto a thumb drive or CD, and then import in on the new computer.

My committee is registered at both the State and County Level. Do I have to use both the Arizona Secretary of State's software and Pima County's software?

No. You may email us a PDF of your State report so that you don't have to enter all your transactions twice.

My committee did not have any activity this period. Do I still have to file a report?

Yes. Your committee has to keep filing reports until it terminates, even if there is no activity.

Will I be fined if my Campaign Finance Report is late?

Yes, you will be fined \$10 a day for the first 15 days the report is late. On the 16th day the report is late, the fee changes to \$25 a day until the report is filed. If the report is not filed within 30 days, the County Attorney will be notified.

Will I be notified if my Campaign Finance Report is late?

Yes, within 5 days after the date the Campaign Finance Report was due, a written email will be sent to each Committee that hasn't filed.
