



PROPOSITION NO. 472

Shall the Governing Board of Altar Valley Elementary School District No. 51 of Pima County, Arizona (the "*District*"), adopt a General Maintenance and Operation Budget that includes an amount that exceeds the revenue control limit specified by statute by 10% for fiscal year 2020/2021 and for six subsequent years as described below? The fiscal year 2020/2021 budget override authority represents a continuation of the existing 10% budget override authority which is scheduled to phase down by one-third for fiscal year 2020/2021, by another one-third for fiscal year 2021/2022, and terminated for fiscal year 2022/2023 if the voters do not approve the continuation.

The amount of the proposed continuation of the budget increase of the proposed budget over the alternate budget for fiscal year 2020/2021 is estimated to be \$151,254. In fiscal years 2020/2021 through 2024/2025 the amount of the proposed increase will be 10% of the District's revenue control limit in each of such years, as provided in Section 15-481(P) of the Arizona Revised Statutes. In fiscal years 2025/2026 and 2026/2027, the amount of the proposed increase will be 6.67% and 3.33%, respectively, of the District's revenue control limit in each of such years, as provided in Section 15-481(P) of the Arizona Revised Statutes.

Any budget increase continuation authorized by this election shall be entirely funded by a levy of taxes on the taxable property in this school district for the year for which adopted and for six (6) subsequent years, shall not be realized from monies furnished by the state and shall not be subject to the limitation on taxes specified in Article IX, Section 18, Constitution of Arizona. Based on the current net assessed valuation used for secondary property tax purposes, to fund the proposed continuation of the increase in the school district's budget would require an estimated continuation of a tax rate of \$0.95 per one hundred dollars of net assessed valuation used for secondary property tax purposes and is in addition to the school district's tax rate that will be levied to fund the school district's revenue control limit allowed by law.

PROPOSICIÓN NO. 472

¿Deberá la Junta de Gobierno del Distrito Escolar de Primaria Núm. 51 de Altar Valley del Condado de Pima, Arizona (el ‘Distrito’), adoptar un Presupuesto General de Mantenimiento y Operaciones que incluye una cantidad que excede el límite del control de ingresos especificado por ley en un 10% para el año fiscal 2020-2021, y por los seis años subsiguientes tal y como se describe debajo? La autoridad de rebase del presupuesto del año fiscal 2020-2021 representa una continuación de la existente autorización de rebase del presupuesto en un 10% el cual está programado para ser reducido en un tercio en el año fiscal 2020/2021 y por otro tercio para el año fiscal 2021/2022, y terminado para el año fiscal 2022/2023 si los electores no aprueban la continuación.

La cantidad de la propuesta continuación del aumento del presupuesto del propuesto presupuesto por encima del presupuesto alternativo para el año fiscal 2020-2021 se estima que es \$151,254. En los años fiscales 2020-2021 hasta el 2024-2025 la cantidad del aumento propuesto será 10% del límite de control de ingresos del Distrito en cada uno de tales años, tal y como lo dispone la sección 15-481 (P) de los Estatutos Enmendados de Arizona. En los años fiscales 2025-2026 y 2026-2027, la cantidad del propuesto aumento será 6.67% y tres y 3.33%, respectivamente, del límite de control de ingresos del Distrito en cada uno de tales años, tal y como se dispone en la sección 15-481 (P) de los Estatutos Enmendados de Arizona.

Cualquier continuación del aumento del presupuesto autorizada por esta elección será financiada enteramente por una imposición de impuestos sobre las propiedades sujetas a impuestos dentro de este distrito escolar en el año para el que se adopte y por los seis años subsiguientes, no será realizada con dinero proporcionado por el estado, y no estará sujeta a las limitaciones de impuestos especificadas en el artículo IX, Sección 18, Constitución de Arizona. Basándose en la actual valoración tasada usada a fines de impuestos secundarios sobre la propiedad, para financiar la propuesta continuación del aumento en el presupuesto del distrito escolar se requerirá una estimada tasa de impuesto de \$0.95 dólares por cada cien dólares de valor impositivo usado a fines de impuestos secundarios sobre la propiedad y es en adición a la tasa de impuesto del distrito escolar que será impuesta para financiar el límite del control de ingresos del distrito escolar permitido por la ley.
