


CERTIFICATION BY THE PIMA COUNTY ACCURACY CERTIFICATION BOARD





PROPOSITION NO. 473

Shall the Governing Board of Flowing Wells Unified School District No. 8 of Pima County, Arizona (the "*District*"), adopt a General Maintenance and Operation Budget that includes an amount that exceeds the revenue control limit specified by statute by ten percent for fiscal year 2020/2021 and for six subsequent years as described below? The fiscal year 2020/2021 budget override authority represents a continuation of the existing ten percent budget override authority which is scheduled to phase down by one-third for fiscal year 2021/2022, by another one-third for fiscal year 2022/2023, and terminated for fiscal year 2023/2024 if the voters do not approve the override.

The amount of the proposed continuation of the budget increase over the alternate budget for fiscal year 2020/2021 is estimated to be \$0. In fiscal years 2020/2021 through 2024/2025 the amount of the proposed increase will be ten percent of the District's revenue control limit in each of such years, as provided in Section 15-481(P) of the Arizona Revised Statutes. In fiscal years 2025/2026 and 2026/2027, the amount of the proposed increase will be six and two-thirds percent and three and one-third percent, respectively, of the District's revenue control limit in each of such years, as provided in Section 15-481(P) of the Arizona Revised Statutes.

Any budget increase continuation authorized by this election shall be entirely funded by a levy of taxes on the taxable property in this school district for the year for which adopted and for six (6) subsequent years, shall not be realized from monies furnished by the state and shall not be subject to the limitation on taxes specified in Article IX, Section 18, Constitution of Arizona. Based on the current net assessed valuation used for secondary property tax purposes, to fund the proposed continuation of the increase in the school district's budget would require an estimated continuation of a tax rate of \$1.53 per one hundred dollars of net assessed valuation used for secondary property tax purposes and is in addition to the school district's tax rate that will be levied to fund the school district's revenue control limit allowed by law.

PROPOSICIÓN NO. 473

¿Deberá la Junta de Gobierno del Distrito Escolar Unificado Núm. 8 de Flowing Wells en el Condado de Pima, Arizona, (el “*Distrito*”) adoptar un Presupuesto General de Mantenimiento y Operaciones que incluye un cantidad que excede el límite del control de ingresos especificado por la ley en un diez por ciento en el año fiscal 2020-2021 y por seis (6) años consecutivos tal y como se describe a continuación? La autorización de rebase del presupuestos para el año fiscal 2020/2021 representa una continuación de la existente autorización de un rebase del presupuesto de un diez por ciento que está programado para reducirse en un tercio en el año fiscal 2021/2022, en otro tercio en el año fiscal 2022/2023 y terminar en el año fiscal 2023/2024 si los electores no aprueban el rebase.

La cantidad de la propuesta continuación del aumento del presupuesto por encima del presupuesto alternativo para el año fiscal 2020/2021 se estima que es \$0. En los años fiscales del 2020/2021 hasta el 2024/2025 la cantidad del propuesto aumento será diez por ciento del límite del control de ingresos del Distrito en cada uno de tales años, tal y como se dispone en la Sección 15-481(P) de los Estatutos Enmendados de Arizona. En los años fiscales 2025/2026 y 2026/2027, la cantidad del aumento propuesto será de 6 y dos tercios por ciento y tres y un tercio por ciento, respectivamente, del límite de control de ingresos del Distrito en cada uno de tales años, tal y como se dispone en la Sección 15-481(P) de los Estatutos Enmendados de Arizona.

Cualquier aumento del presupuesto autorizado por esta elección será financiado enteramente por una imposición de impuestos sobre las propiedades sujetas a impuestos en este distrito escolar en el año por el que es adoptado y por los seis (6) años siguientes, no será realizado con dinero proporcionado por el estado, y no estará sujeto a las limitaciones de impuestos especificadas en el artículo IX, Sección 18, de la Constitución de Arizona. Basándose en un cálculo de la valoración fiscal usada a fines de impuestos secundarios sobre la propiedad, para financiar el propuesto aumento en el presupuesto del distrito escolar se requerirá una estimada tasa de impuesto de \$1.53 por cada cien dólares de valor impositivo usado a fines de impuestos secundarios sobre la propiedad y es en adición a la tasa de impuesto del distrito escolar que será impuesta para financiar el límite del control de ingresos del distrito escolar permitido por la ley.
